

Transfer files to and from Kraken

The Java Applet is slow and it takes extra time to access to work space we use, so move files to and from your home directory instead i.e. if you are in a directory with a file such as out.tgz that you want to download, issue the following command

```
~> cp out.tgz ~/
```

The tilde key is a shortcut to your home directory. This is the directory you are in when you first login.

- 1) Login to the XSEDE User Portal
- 2) Go to RESOURCES > File Manager
The left panel will be a directory of the local computer and the right panel is for XSEDE files.
- 3) Double click on NICS Kraken Cray XT5 (in the right panel)
- 4) This will put you in your home directory
- 5) Navigate to the local directory you want to copy files to or from (in the left panel)
- 6) Drag file from one panel to the other.

If you copied files to Kraken and want to move them from your home directory to your working directory, issue the following command

```
~> mv ~/files.tgz $CUE_SCRATCH
```

or if you are in the directory you want to copy files to, issue the following command

```
~> mv ~/files.tgz .
```
